KIND OF WORK:

Supervisory work in directing the activities of Utilities Maintenance Technicians engaged in the maintenance, repair, planning, construction, operation and replacement of Board facilities and systems; and related work as required.

Overtime and special shift assignment could be required. This position is considered essential in case of an emergency.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) High School Diploma. Original High School Diploma or Original G.E.D. Equivalency Diploma issued by a State Department of Education must be presented at the time of application.
- 2) Valid Louisiana Driver's license. Driver's license must be submitted at the time of application.
- 3) One (1) year of experience as a Utilities Maintenance Technician II or Utilities Skilled Maintenance Technician with the Sewerage & Water Board.

A rating of training and experience, weighted 100%. Credit will only be given for experience gained within the last ten (10) years.
