Annunciation	All restoration work is completed at the site and is currently under turf maintenance. The contractor has asked to continue maintaining the area for a few more weeks as there are some areas that are still browning.
Bunny Friend	The site should be completed in 2 weeks or less. The contractor has received an extension as there existed delays in the schedule - due to the fence changes and tree stump removal at the site. The contractor will be performing cleanup and repairs to the sod at the Gallier Street entrance (the contractors parked on the street towards the end of the restoration as several items were stolen from their vehicles while on site and parked on the street - the grass near the entrance from traffic will be repaired)
McCue Playground	Bids for the final restoration at this site are due at the end of this week. FEMA will review this information early next week with an award shortly thereafter. Note that FEMA has spoken to NORD and the entire basketball court will be replaced due to the additional subsidence that occurred since our last visit.
Avenger	Bids for the final restoration at this site are due at the end of this week. FEMA will review this information early next week with an award shortly thereafter.
St. Roch	FEMA met with NORD and their plumbing contractor on 7-14-09 and 7-15-09. We agreed that the break under the building in the sewage pipe will be handled by NORD, and FEMA will be prepared to make repairs to damages in the pipe located outside. Note that FEMA went to the site to dig by the building with NORD's confirmation on 7-17-09 = no cleanout was discovered and the cast iron pipe was intact 4 feet outside the building. FEMA is working on getting the paperwork together for their repairs and would like to coordinate with NORD.
