To apply, bring the original of the following:

- Proof of HOUSEHOLD Income
(3 recent check stubs, Social Security Award Letter, Food Stamp and/or Welfare Award Letter-TANF)
- Proof of Address (i.e. utility bill, rent receipt)
- Birth Certificate
- Social Security Card
- Proof of Selective Services (males ages 18-24)
- Current school report card (in-school youth only)
- Diploma/Withdraw Slip/Drop notice (out-of-school youth only)
- Current Photo ID (school or government issued)
- Proof of Barrier
(basic skills deficient; school drop-out; homeless, runaway/foster child; offender; pregnant/parenting)
- Proof of Health Insurance (If no health insurance coverage, call JOB1 for details)
- Youth under the age of 18 must bring a Parent or Legal Guardian
(Must have proof of guardianship)
