PARK NAME	STATUS
Annunciation	All restoration work has been completed at the site. The maintenance period for the turf has begun and the site is estimated to be completed by mid-July.
Bunny Friend	The contractors are currently working on fence repairs and preparation for the new playground elements. NORD also visited the site on 6-18-09, to which a new request was put in for an additional set of bleachers and alterations to the one included in the current contract, as well as an alteration to the fence installation behind the backstop that was settled prior to the contract being released. FEMA has reviewed this information; yet prior to site construction, only one set of bleachers existed, and the current fence installation was requested by NORD and agreed to by NORD prior to the contract being released. Therefore, FEMA can not comply with the request. The remaining site restoration work is still estimated to be completed by mid-July.
McCue Playground	This site was visited on 6-18-09 for the final acceptance walkthrough. During the walkthrough, NORD made a new request for an additional light pole, had concerns about an area that has been vandalized by vehicular damage, and questioned the slope of the asphalt basketball court. FEMA has reviewed the documentation regarding the additional light, and per the photo documentation, an additional light was not present prior to site construction and therefore will not be installed. FEMA is currently reviewing the new turf and basketball court concerns and will get with NORD on the next course of action.
Avenger	This site was visited on 5-29-09 for the final acceptance walkthrough. NORD had verbally accepted the site in early April. FEMA and the City of NOLA attempted to work out the ROC issues during April and May. During that time, the site received extensive recreational play on the fields that caused significant damage to the turf, to which NORD stated was a deficiency in the turf establishment. As so, FEMA is currently working to get a new contract issued to repair the damages.
