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The LDEQ *Debris Clearing, Removal and Disposal Guidelines* for Hurricane Katrina is included in **Appendix B**.

### 3.3 Landfill Sites

The City is responsible for the identification of landfill sites for the disposal of the storm-generated debris. The **Tables 3-3, 3-4 and 3-5** contains the landfill sites identified for use under the debris mission.

The Gentilly C&D Landfill and the Hwy 90 C&D Landfill are presently being utilized for the disposal of C&D waste for the City's debris mission. The Gentilly C&D Landfill has been approved by LDEQ for operation 24 hours per day-7days per week. The letter authorizing a modification to the operating hours is presented in **Appendix D**.

The Recovery 1 site is a closed landfill, and has been approved to LDEQ for the utilization of wood chips for erosion control at the site. The LDEQ approval is contained in **Appendix D**.

The City and LDEQ have been in discussions with another Type III C&D Landfill site along Chef Menteur Highway in New Orleans. The site has submitted a permit application to the LDEQ prior to Hurricane Katrina. Final approval is pending.

### **3.4 Other Methods of Reduction and Final Deposition of Debris**

The City owns the Gentilly C&D Landfill, and has a contract with AMID-Metro, LLC to operate the facility. Prior to Hurricane Katrina, the Gentilly C&D Landfill provide the City with a long-term facility for C&D disposal. The City wants to preserve the landfill air space, and supports other methods of reduction and final disposal of the storm debris.

The City has reviewed other methods of final deposition and waste reduction methods for the storm related debris. The methods of final deposition of debris reviewed by the City include the following:

1. Utilizing existing landfills for disposal
2. Disposal of "Waste in Place" (not approved by the City)
3. Developing new landfill near impacted area
4. Barging waste to remote landfill
5. Waste to Energy
6. Reduction of C&D waste by chipping
7. Air curtain box burning

A comparison of the landfill alternatives and proposals for barging waste to a remote landfill and "Waste to Energy" are included in **Appendix E**. The City does not approve of "Waste in Place", however is in favor of utilizing existing landfills for disposal. Developing new landfill near the impacted area, barging waste to a remote landfill and using "waste to energy" as disposal methods are under review by the City as viable options for disposal of the storm debris.

The City in conjunction with the LDEQ, EPA and USACE has conducted a test burn demonstration of wood waste using the air curtain burner. The city has recommended the use of air curtain box burner for reducing the wood waste. The information on the test burn is included in **Appendix E**. Open burning or pit burning is not an approved method of reduction with the City.

The City supports other methods of reduction in the volume of the waste disposed in landfills, such as, chipping of wood waste and C&D waste. Chipping of C&D waste is being utilized in surrounding parishes as method to reduce the amount of waste disposed in landfills.

### **3.5 Rights of Entry**

The City is for providing Rights of Entry (ROE) to the USACE in order to gain access to property to remove, process, reduce and dispose of storm generated debris. **Table 3-6** contains a list of the ROEs obtained as part of the debris mission.

### 3.2 Temporary Debris Staging and Reduction Sites (TDSRS)

The City is responsible for the identification and securing approval from Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality of TDSRS. The Department of Sanitation has work closely with the identification of the TDSRSs within the City of New Orleans. The **Table 3-2** contains a list of the LDEQ approved TDSRSs located in Orleans Parish. Copies of the LDEQ approval to operate and operation criteria for the TDSRSs are included in **Appendix B**.
